Rainwater holding capacity increased from 1.304m litres to 2.260m litres. Volunteer hours were put into constructing the base and pitching the rainwater harvesting systems.

WATER TANKS

*In partnership with Water Authority Fiji.*

5,300 litre water tanks were sourced for the Yasawa villages and communities with the help of Habitat for Humanity and the NZ government. Volunteer hours pitched & hooked up these tanks to ensure fresh drinking water is available year round.
